

AIP Organizational Chart

Directions for Navigation

To move around or through the AIP Org Chart, please note the following:

- When the chart first opens, you may see (or choose to open) a list of bookmarks to the left side of the chart. Each bookmark is a link and can take you directly to that page. This list of bookmarks can be closed if you prefer to view the chart without them.
- The Table of Contents, on the second page of the Org Chart, has an organized listing of all departments. Like the bookmarks mentioned earlier, each department title is a direct link to that department's page of the chart.
- The very last few pages of the Org Chart include an Index. The index provides a way of navigating directly to an individual within the chart, again as a direct link from that page.
- While on a given page of the Org Chart, you may see a small yellow box with an arrow pointing upward or downward. If upward, the arrow indicates the large department or division under which this page falls. If downward, the arrow indicates that there is a larger grouping of staff reporting to that individual, on an additional page. Clicking on that yellow box and arrow will take you directly to that previous or next page.
- Due to certain sizing limitations, some pages use smaller boxes and font size than others. It may be necessary for you to adjust your "zoom" feature on a given page to achieve your desired page size and legibility of the text.
- If you so choose, you may also select "Full Screen Mode" under the "Window" menu, which will make the chart fill your screen. You can then navigate with your arrows (on your keyboard) or with your mouse. To exit this mode, press "Esc" on your keyboard.
