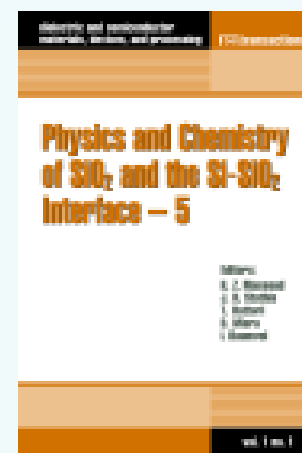

Rapid access to papers from ECS meetings and ECS-sponsored meetings

ECS Transactions (ECST) offers online access to full-text papers presented at ECS meetings and ECS-sponsored meetings. One volume is published for each meeting. Each volume contains many issues, and each issue includes a collection of papers on a specific topic. In many cases, the full-length papers are available approximately 10 days before the meeting at which the papers are being presented. Other articles become available to readers approximately 12 weeks after the meeting, a significant advance in publication time for this content. Abstracts residing in *ECS Meeting Abstracts*, freely available online, will be linked to a full paper if it has been published in ECST. If an ECST paper goes on to be accepted in one of ECS's peer-reviewed technical journals, ECST will carry a "forward link" to that published article.
